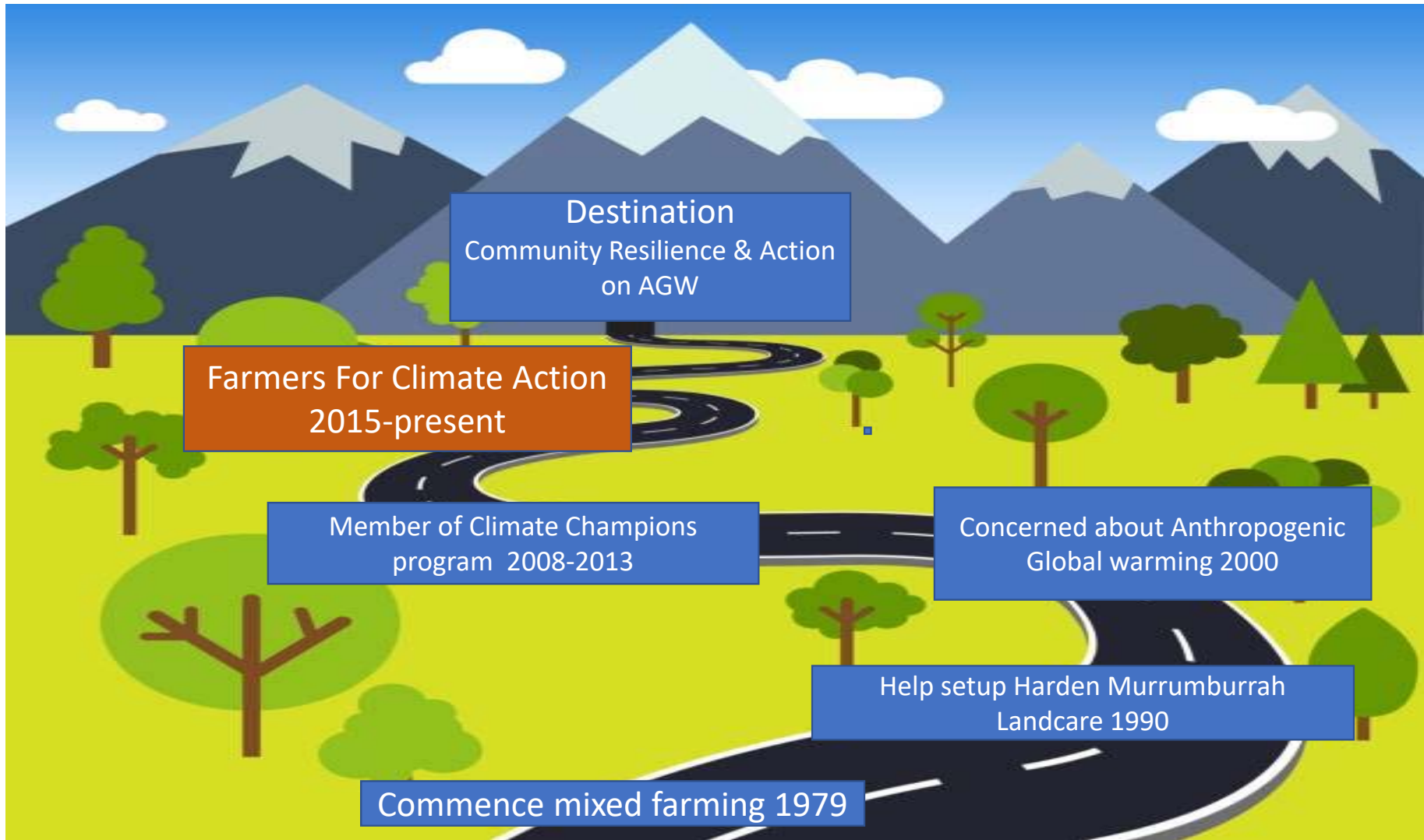

Strategy – Engagement – Forming a structure of members such that they can develop a collective voice for issues both locally and globally (Very much a community landcare model)

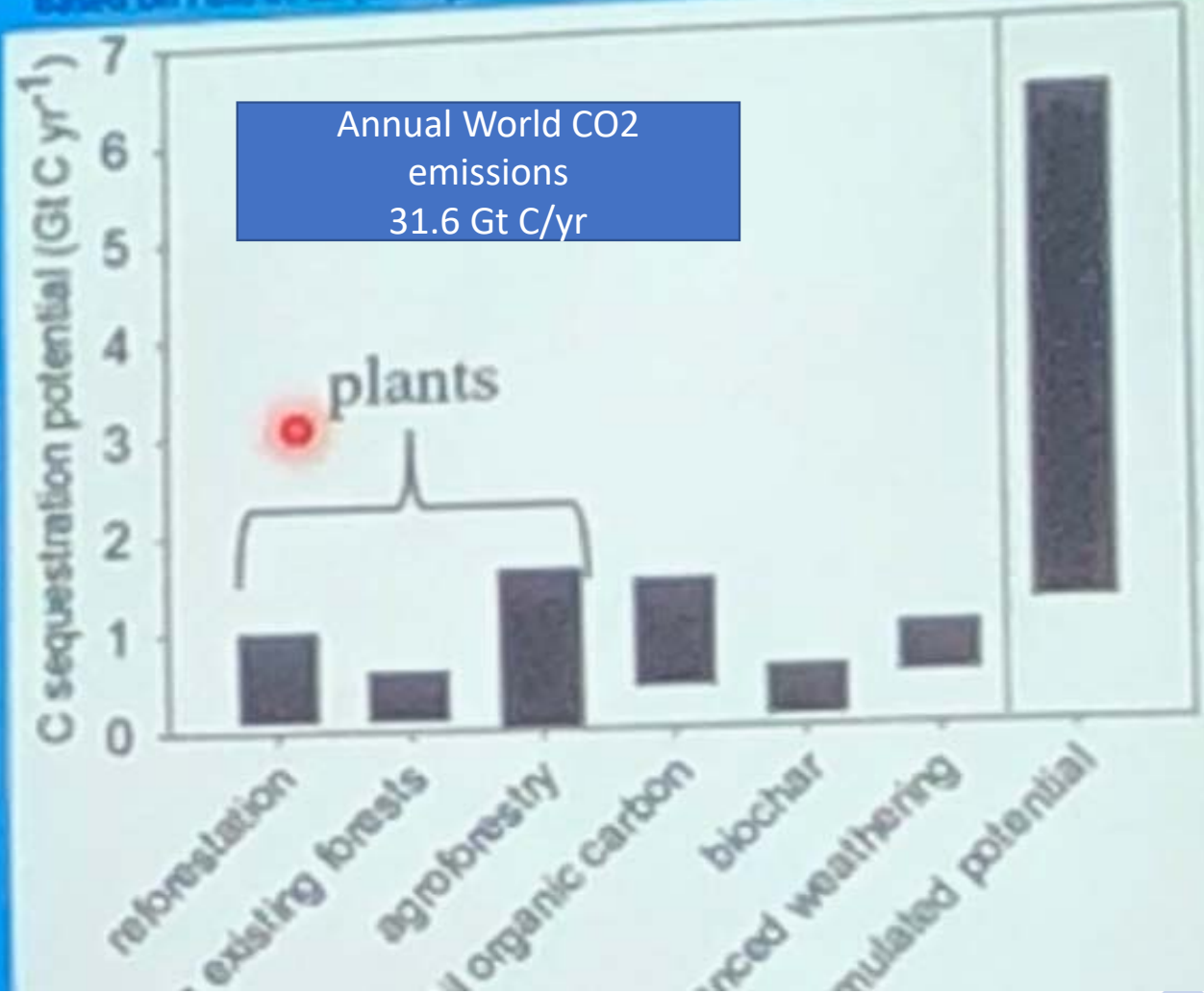
Extension – Provide a linking mechanism for communities and researchers to assist best practice
