


What is Landcarer?

- Provides a number of tools to assist landcarers with project and group management





4 Main Sections of Landcarer – People


- People is the section where you find individuals to network with
- You can connect, message, view each other's posts, and invite each other to different landcare projects and events
















4 Main Sections of Landcarer – Groups

- In a group you can share information, coordinate events, store documentation, and create elearning modules, videos, podcasts and stories.




4 Main Sections of Landcarer – Topics

- In a topic you can also share information, coordinate events, store documentation, and create elearning modules, videos, podcasts and stories.




4 Main Sections of Landcarer – Projects




Landcare Smart Farm - Natural Capital Accounting P

Why Landcarer?


- A collection of tools to help enhance our interaction and project management in landcare

- A platform that helps you find other people in the landcare community, network, and share knowledge







New Horizons – Data Management

- Capturing the on-ground achievements in landcare
- Would enable data capture, collation and report generation





Data Management – Current Challenges

- The data capture that currently does occur happens in many places, without much communication among different sources
- Different groups have different amounts of funding to use data capture tools
- Certain important contributions made by landcare are often underreported and unrecognised




Data Management - Challenges Faced by a New Tool

- Are landcare activities, as well as the desires of landcarers for what to report on, too diverse for one tool to capture all that data?
- Doesn't the introduction of another tool burden people already reporting with more work?



Data Management - Spatial Mapping

- Provide visual representation as well as numerical
- Make it easy to locate active projects
- Make recruitment easier for landcare groups running projects
- Solves concerns over doubled up reporting
